The historical city of Tabriz is the political and administrative center of East Āzarbāyjān province. It is located at latitude 38 04` north and longitude 46 17` east. Tabriz is located in 600 km. north west of Tehrān. It is linked to the capital by daily train, air flights and buses.

**QEYSARIYEH (Bāzār)**

The history of covered Qeysariyeh Bāzār belongs to the 14th century. In this Bāzār carpets, rugs, silks, leather goods and jewels are traded. This Bāzār is in Motahari Street.

Municipality building is in Sāt Square and was built during Pahlavi (first) dynasty. It consists of a castle and clock with 4 sides. The height of the clock is 30.5 meters. The plan of building looks like a flying eagle.

MASJED-e KABOUD

MASJED-e KABOUD is a famous mosque which is covered by blue tiles in Tabriz. It was built in 1464 AC during the governing of Jahān Shāh while Tabriz was the capital.

This building belongs to Safaviyeh and Qājāriyeh dynasty. It is located in south east of Tabriz . It is in the center of a big pool and is surrounded by a beautiful park and some entertainment facilities.
